

Illinois Watercolor Society Members Show 2020

August 1 - September 30, 2020



IWS is thrilled to have Peggy Macnamara serve as the 2020 IWS Members Show juror. Macnamara earned her MA in art history from the University of Chicago and has served as both the Artist-in-Residence at Chicago's Field Museum of Natural History since 1990, and as an Associate Professor at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. She has traveled with Field Museum scientists all over the world to paint nature and illustrate conservation efforts. She has published 4 books in collaboration with museum scientists through University of Chicago Press and created two children's books.

The Illinois Watercolor Society was founded in 1981 by a group of ten artists living in the Chicagoland area and lead by Charles Strissel as president. The membership grew quickly and IWS held its first exhibition at the Redfield Estate at The Grove in Glenview, IL in 1984. Throughout the next two decades, IWS continued to hold annual exhibitions and membership grew to include over a hundred artists. In 1999, Charles Strissel retired as president and Dana Nash took over. During this time the annual exhibition moved to other locations such as the Schaumburg Prairie Center for the Arts and the National Arts Foundation in Skokie, IL. A separate, annual members show was started and originally held at the High Risk gallery in Chicago. IWS also began sponsoring demonstrations from nationally recognized artists such as Nita Engle and Zoltan Szabo. In 2007, Tony Armendariz became the IWS Executive Director and with Carole Hennessy, continued sponsoring the National Show, the Members Show and members meetings featuring art demonstrations. IWS also held a Signature Show in 2013 and Small Waters shows in 2012 and 2019. In 2015, a Board of Directors was established and in 2017, Benita Brewer became the IWS Director. Today, with over 180 members, IWS continues to sponsor two shows each year and has partnered with the Oak Brook Public library to hold the bi-monthly meetings which feature artist demonstrations.

The mission of the Illinois Watercolor Society is to advance the education and caliber of watercolor painting throughout Illinois. We encourage the practice and appreciation of water-based media at all skill levels. Benefits to membership include a newsletter featuring members' events and accomplishments, a website for members to use as a learning and promotional resource, exhibitions and artistic demonstrations. Artists of all skill levels are encouraged to join IWS.

Juror's Statement:

The 2020 show is a tribute to the artists of Illinois. Five novices all produced work worthy of a prize or at least admiration. Each of the five pieces from the novices showed incredible promise. So I hope to see these artists at the next exhibit.

I felt the flower studies were exceptionally well done. *Tiger Lily Tango*, *Purple Bearded Iris*, and *Stumped In Blue Gill Prairie* showed watercolor at its best. The loose abstract work like *Conifer* has an appeal that has always brought viewers to watercolor. I think what the show exhibits is that watercolor can be used for strict realism, light abstraction, as well as inventive expression.

It was very hard to single out six pieces for the excellent awards. I had at least twelve on my list and it would have grown if I had seen the originals. One juror's opinion is nothing more than one juror's opinion. Although you try to remain totally unbiased, some thoughts just slip into the process. I've always been challenged by composition. There are rules but a good composition pulls the whole piece together without being obvious. The color, value, and shapes are just where they should be. I think a good composition signals experience and understanding of the subtleties of painting.

I'll close with my favorite Michelangelo quote, "If people knew how hard I had to work to get my mastery, it wouldn't seem so wonderful at all."


